Eye Camp Conducted in Aruvikkara Panchayat

An eye camp was conducted for Aruvikkara Panchayat at the Bethelgiri CSI Church, Cheriyakonni, on 14th February 2015. The medical team from the Regional Institute of Ophthalmology consisted of Doctors Vidhya and Jisha, Technicians: Sukanya, Sithara, Subina and Seles, and Eye Bank Counsellor Santhi.

A total of 107 patients, consisting of 42 men and 65 women, were examined. Seven cataract cases were detected. They will be followed up with surgery. Forty three patients were given medicines and 38 were given spectacles.

Mr.K.John, Hon. Director, Prof.(Dr) Philipose Joshua, Hon. Secretary, Mr. Baby Kurien, Hon. Jt. Secretary, Mr. Chacko Mathai, Manager (Admin), Mr.Faustin M Rajan, Manager (CBR), Office staff and Community Workers consisted of the organizing team. Rev. ArunKumar, Vicar and the Parishoners of the Bethelgiri CSI Church rendered all cooperation for the successful conduct of the eye camp.




CBR Program: House of Sheela gets new roof

Sheela Soman (33 Yrs) Vellanad

She has been suffering from poly arthritis from the age of nine. She suffers pain in all joints. As a result her steps are not steady and she tends to fall frequently. Her father suffers heart and asthmatic problems. Mother is having mental depression. Sheela is the eldest of three sisters and both the younger ones are married. She is provided continuously with the medicines she requires. The roof of her house has been dilapidated and it was renovated by repairing the structure and replacing the roof tiles with fibre sheets, at a total cost of about ₹ 52,000 - , thanks to the Holy Trinity Prayer Fellowship, Orthodox Church Centre, lloor, Trivandrum which donated the amount.
