

## **CBR Program: PMR Field Visit**

The Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation field visit for this month was conducted to Vattiyoorkavu Panchayat on 22nd July2015. Dr. G.Chitra, Dr. K.P. Sharija and Dr. V. Abhiram from the Dept. of Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation, Medical College, Trivandrum visited seven bed-ridden patients. It was followed up with supply of medicines and equipment as prescribed. The team of doctors were accompanied by Prof (Dr) Philipose Joshua, Hon. Secretary, Mr. Faustin M Rajan, Manager (CBR), and Mrs. Sindhu, Community Worker.



K. Vasantha (63), suffering from osteoarthritis. Cannot walk freely. Lives with two mentally retarded, unmarried daughters. Only son was a cerebral palsy patient and was highly crippled. He and the father died a few years ago.




R. Soman Pillai (56) had been a mason. He fell down from the roof of his own house during construction, in January 2015. He has suffered spinal injury and has become paralyzed since then. He stays in a rented house.

Lalkumar B. (48) fell from a tree and suffered spinal injury, some six years ago.

Sathi G. (50), suffered from Polio Myelitis at a young age. She has one son who is now married and is a laborer. They stay in a rented house.





Santhosh S. (36) fell from the top the roof of his own house some two and a half years ago and suffered spinal injury. He is now bed-ridden. His father too suffered a stroke and is our client.

Prasanna R. (61) was hit by lightning twice, first time in 1981 and again in 1987. She walks with great difficulty as she suffers from arthritis.

Thulaseedharan S. (63) suffered a stroke a couple of years ago. His movement is highly restricted. His is also severely diabetic.


