Eye Camp at Vellanad Panchayat

An eye camp was held on 19 Nov. 2015 at Bethel Gospel Assemblies Church Hall, Kokkothamangalam, Vellanad Panchayat. A medical team consisting of Dr. Vijayasree, Assoc.Professor, Ms.Shahana S.B. and Ms.Sajini S Nair (Both Optometrists) from the Regional Institute of Ophthalmology, Trivandrum examined a total of 139 patients out of which 50 were male and the rest female. Forty five patients were given free medicines on the spot, 57 were supplied with free spectacles and 23 were identified for cataract surgery which was followed up subsequently.

A team of volunteers from MGRC consisting of Prof. D.Mathew (Vice President, Mr.K.John (Hon.Director), Mr.G.T.Punnose (Hon.Jt.Director), Prof (Dr) Philipose Joshua (Hon.Secretary), Mr.P.T.Baby John (Hon.Treasurer), Dr.Mariamma Daniel and Mrs. Omana John (Ex.Committee members), Mr. Faustin M. Rajan (Manager-CBR), community workers, and office staff gave leadership in the camp. The cooperation of volunteers from the Bethel Church is gratefully acknowledged.


