PMR Field Visit

The field visit of the medical team this month was conducted on 27 January 2016 to Aruvikkara Panchayat. Dr. Selvan, Dr.Prabhu, and Dr. Ancy from the Dept. of Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation, MCH, Trivandrum, examined the patients and prescribed treatments. Medicines prescribed were supplied the following day itself. Mr. & Mrs. K.J.Punnathara, Mrs. Sosanna Kuruvilla, Mr. Faustin M Rajan, Manager (CBR), and Mrs. D. Omana (Community Worker), accompanied the medical team.

Selvaraj's house gets a roof

Selvaraj (55), a resident of Aruvikkara Panchayat, who used to be a construction worker, suffered an attack of TB some eight years ago. Though he received treatment for the same, he could not go for any work since then due to his incapacitation. In addition to that he also suffered a stroke some four months ago and became partially paralyzed. He and his family have been living in a house which had no roof. A couple of old tin sheets and pieces of tarpaulin that were used could not provide any protection from the rains and the harsh sun. MGRC undertook for his continued treatment and also provided a new roof for his house with new fibre sheets. The estimate for the roofing was ₹.60,000/- and we got a collection of ₹.60,100/- part of which came from the offering taken at the Christmas get together conducted by Rev. Fr. Geevarghese Mekattu, at the Orthodox Student Centre, and the major share was contributed by Mr. James Abraham, a well wisher of MGRC.





