"MGRC News" has entered the seventh year of its publication. It was started with the sole intention of keeping our members and well-wishers updated about what is happening at MGRC and its ministry among the hundreds of its clients spread across six panchayats in Trivandrum, who are not only poor but also either physically or mentally challenged. In its ministry since the beginning 34 years ago, MGRC has catered to many hundreds of such people, providing medical, economic and social rehabilitation in their own community rather than bringing them to stay at a common centre.

The quality of life of many of these people had tremendously improved by the intervention of MGRC in their lives. Many who had been bed-ridden for years had started walking by getting proper treatment. Hundreds of aids and equipment such as canes, walkers, crutches, splints, braces, artificial limbs, spectacles, etc. have been distributed in the past. Many found a way of earning a livelihood for themselves by starting some small business such as petty shops, goat/chicken/rabbit rearing, tailoring, etc. Hundreds of physically or mentally challenged children or healthy children of physically or mentally challenged parents have been provided help for education. The prayerful participation of our members and well-wishers made all these possible.

I wish "MGRC News" will continue to serve as a link between MGRC and its members and well-wishers as it had done in the past.

Eye Camp

An eye camp was conducted for Aruvikkara Panchayat on 20 January 2017 at the CSI Church Hall, Irayancode, Cheriyakonni. One hundred and seventy five patients were examined, out of which 63 were male and 112 were female. Twenty six people were identified with cataract, and five with glaucoma. Medicines were given to 48 and spectacles prescribed for 55.

Dr.Jesline Johnson and Dr. Sithara T.V. and Optometrists Pournami G.D, Shalini J., Kavya Mohan, and Lekshmi C.J., from the Regional Institute of Ophthalmology, Trivandrum Examined the patients.

A team of Office bearers, Executive Committee Members, and staff of MGRC gave leadership to the eye camp.

New well dug for Thangaraj and family

Thangaraj of Karakulam Panchayat had been a daily wages worker. They live in a small house built on a hill top. They used to draw water from their neighbor's well at the foothill. Eventually both Thangaraj and his wife fell sick and both were unable to do any physical work. Moreover, the source of water in their neighbor's well at the foothill also started diminishing and there was acute shortage of water. It was at this juncture MGRC decided to step in and arranged to dig a well at their premises. The initial expectation was to find water at 40' depth. But it went deeper and finally water was found at 56' depth. Even during this dry spell about 5-6' depth of water was available in the newly dug well at the hilltop. A pump was also fitted and the total cost worked out to be ₹ 70,000/-. The local panchayat also stepped in to give their timely help by providing ₹ 19,000/- which is the cost of digging 15'.

Now Thangaraj and family has sufficient water available through the tap at their door step and it is a great relief for them.
